Research...

57 sea turtles tracks of nesting-19 hatchlings during surveys on Tetiaroa's atoll.

More than 250 observations collected thanks to the Marine mammals and sea turtles Observatory in French Polynesia.

5 Research projects initiated: studies on bonefish populations, in-water monitoring of sea turtles' populations around Moorea, sea turtles nest monitoring and sand beaches temperature effects on sea turtles on Tetiaroa's atoll, development of a 3-year action plan of conservation, research and education as part of the Marine mammals and sea turtles observatories.

1 student on thesis and 1 veterinarian in internship welcomed.

Conservation...

47 sea turtles welcomed at the Sea turtle Clinic of which 5 released into the wild. In 9 years: 339 welcomed - 131 relased.

1 loggerhead turtle equipped with satellite tags travelled 6 500 km in 194 days.

57 green turtles nest tracks listed on Tetiaroa's atoll.

6m3 of waste collected with 200 teenagers of Moorea's island.


16 conferences and training courses provided based on conservation of the polynesian marine ecosystem.

3 700 persons participed to 13 events such as the World Festival of Underwater pictures, the World Ocean Day, Science days...

Our President became the representant of the Pacific the strandings national network, and is also now founder member of the French foundation for of the World Ocean Network.



8 400 school children welcomed - 1 482 educational programs realized for the 2012-2013 school year. In 9 years: 48 000 welcomed.

2 educational booklets created - 15 000 specimens delivered for free: Booklet «Tohorā, humpback whale who are-you?», «Booklet on sea turtles in French Polynesia».

1 100 students awared for the environment conservation through 5 pedagogic projects - 49 interventions on Tahiti and Moorea - 2 contests organized: conservation of cetaceans in French Polynesia, knowledge of the good management of the marine areas of Moorea, introduction to the water preservation («Water kit» from the Maud Fontenoy Fondation), protection of the sea turtles in French Polynesia, awareness of the coral reefs substainabilities.

33 newspapers articles provided 2 800 teenagers and public having participated to the 2013 Science Festival

200 persons sensibilized through 13 conferences.

Participation to 8 national and international meetings.

100 students trained during 12 sessions organized.

200 guides to observe dolphins and whales in French Polynesia - 100 submersible identification cards, created and diffused to the public.
